#### **Friday 10 June 11.00 am: Catherine Causley - Net Zero by 2040**

Catherine is the climate change officer for East Devon district council and a passionate environmental activist with a focus on community action.

She says “I believe that the system is best changed from the inside and I have dedicated myself to working from within the system to affect change. I have been involved with many community projects and have recently worked with another local woman to set up East Devon’s first library of things at Exmouth. Until recently I was on the board of my local Transition Town group which is a local action group originally aimed at helping communities transition from a high carbon lifestyle as we moved beyond peak oil, the focus has changed slightly but community action and support is still at the heart of what they do”

Prior to joining East Devon district council Catherine was the Reuse officer at Devon county council, joining EDDC in June last year. “My biggest achievement to date was coordinating the World’s largest repair event which saw over 2500 items fixed in a single day by the repair café network and involved 68 separate cafes all running at the same time, with over 1000 volunteers pitching in as storm Dennis raged around us. The sum total cost to the council was £17 in total and that was for stamps”
