### Chair's Annual Report 2020

We did in fact manage three of the six sessions with four boys and seven girls when it was sadly cancelled due to Covid. None of us at the beginning of the year could have imagined what was about to happen.

Not only were we hit by the pandemic, but as an organisation were the victim of a scam. This happened on 4 March 2020, just before lockdown. Thankfully, the money (£1084.09) was recovered and returned to our bank account on 16 July 2020. It has been a very difficult 10 months. The national u3a Finance Manager Kevin Traynor has been very supportive to us through this extremely challenging time.

Everyone must be watchful for scams. The committee has recently had a similar approach from scammers to last time. Thankfully, as a group, we realised what was happening. It shows that we must all be constantly vigilant in this online world. There are some very mean people out there!

#### Talks

Despite Covid and all the difficulties, we have managed to run the main monthly and the Science & Technology talks online using Zoom and Webex. For the monthly talk this meant finding a new

list of speakers as most already booked did not want to give online talks, or were retiring from speaking.

This has given us the opportunity to use more local talent and several of our members volunteered to help out. A big thank you to them all.

## **Membership Renewals**

Annual subscriptions would have become due on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 but because of our reduced activities, and our sound financial position, the committee have decided that u3a membership will be free for existing members for 2021. New or lapsed members will pay, as usual, £12 for single membership, £22 for joint and £8.50 for associates.

## **Statement of Accounts 2019 - 2020**

The financial year 2019 – 20 presented many twists and turns for Lyme Regis u3a, not least due to the scam and the effects of COVID-19. However, as can be seen from the Statement of Accounts, the year ended successfully with a surplus of £4749 and this has enabled us to provide free subscriptions for members for this year.

Unfortunately it must be noted that this surplus is mainly due to three items that will not be repeated. Firstly a repayment of Gift Aid of £3044, secondly a surplus on trips, and thirdly low administration costs. The surplus on trips would probably have been greatly reduced if we had been able to complete the year normally and arrange further trips, and the low administration costs are certainly due to the reduced activities.

In the 'Admin and Expenses' category we have a large credit. This is the result of the scam being taken out and repaid.

Overall we must be pleased with our financial situation, putting us in a strong position for the restart of all of our activities after the horrors of COVID-19.
